

Barbara Caputo is Full Professor at Polytechnic of Turin, where she directs the university's Center of Excellence on AI (AI-H@PoliTo). She received her PhD in Computer Science from Stockholm Polytechnic University (KTH), Sweden in 2005. From 2006 to 2013 she was a research manager at the IDIAP Research Institute, an AI research center affiliated with EPFL. In 2013 she returned to Italy as an associate professor at the University of Rome La Sapienza with a direct call due to clear fame. From 2017 to 2021 she was research director at the Italian Institute of Technology. She is a co-founder of the European Laboratory for Learning and Intelligent Systems Society, where she served as a member of the Board of Directors from 2019 to 2022, and an ELLIS fellow (www.ellis.eu). She led the National Doctorate on AI & Industry from 2021 to 2022 and she is the Advisor of the Rector of Polytechnic of Turin on Artificial Intelligence. She was part of the 30 MISE experts and the 9 MITD experts who developed the Italian National Strategy on AI. She is one of the 'Inspiring Fifty' 2018 (<https://italy.inspiringfifty.org/italy-2018>), of the 100 experts of the Bracco foundation's initiative '100 experts for Italy' (<https://100esperte.it/>). She was the first Italian winner of an ERC award in the field of computer vision in 2014. She appeared on the Mickey Mouse Magazine with her alter-ego 'Barb Quackut' in 2020; in 2021 she received an Honorary Doctorate from the University of Southern Denmark for her contributions to the field of AI applied to computer vision and robotics. She sits as an independent director on the Board of Directors of Ites Reale, Ites Reale Espana, Teoresi SpA and Infocamere. In 2022 she co-founded the start-up Focoos.ai, a spin-off of the Polytechnic of Turin, of which she became president in the spring of 2023.
